

3. On May 27, 2010, Public Utility District No. 1 of Douglas County (“Douglas PUD”) filed with the Commission its Final License Application for relicensing the Wells Hydroelectric Project.

4. Puget is a regulated investor-owned electric utility that serves retail customers in the State of Washington and makes wholesale purchases and sales throughout the Western United States.


5. Puget entered into an agreement with Wells PUD on September 18, 1963 to purchase a percentage of the output of the Wells Hydroelectric Project. This agreement is effective through August 31, 2018.

6. Puget has a right to intervene in these proceedings pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure. Any determination made as a result of these proceedings may have a significant impact upon Puget, and no other party can represent Puget’s interests.
