## MOTION TO INTERVENE OF PACIFICORP

Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") (18 C.F.R. 385 § 214 (2008)), PacifiCorp hereby files this motion to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support hereof, PacifiCorp states as follows:

1. PacifiCorp is an investor-owned utility with its principal place of business in Portland, Oregon. PacifiCorp is primarily engaged in the business of providing electric service to retail customers in six western states: Oregon, Washington, California, Wyoming, Utah, and Idaho. As a vertically integrated utility, PacifiCorp is responsible for providing reliable and efficient electric service to more than 1.7 million consumers, and is one of the lowest-cost electricity producers in the United States. In addition, PacifiCorp provides electric transmission service in nine western states and owns or has interest in *i*.) approximately 15,900 miles of transmission lines and *ii*.) 78 generating plants across the west to include thermal, hydroelectric, wind-powered and geothermal facilities with total generating capability of more than 10,400 megawatts. PacifiCorp provides electric transmission service pursuant to a Commission-approved open access transmission tariff and operates an integrated system spanning two control areas, PacifiCorp East and PacifiCorp West. wholesale market with public and private utilities, energy marketing companies and incorporated municipalities as a result of excess electricity generation or other system balancing activities.

- 2. On May 27, 2010, Public Utility District No. 1 of Douglas County ("Douglas PUD") filed with the Commission its *Final License Application for relicensing the Wells Hydroelectric Project* ("Wells Project"). As stated in the Douglas PUD application, PacifiCorp is one of four purchasers under long-term contracts with Douglas PUD for the purchase of the Wells Project output. PacifiCorp's contract with Douglas, which gives PacifiCorp the right to purchase 6.59% of the output of the Wells Project and includes a right of first refusal ("ROFR"), runs through August 31, 2018. This ROFR will give PacifiCorp the right to continue to purchase Wells Project output during the term of a new license issued by the Commission. Further, as Douglas PUD recognizes in its application, the daily operation of the Wells Project is influenced by several factors including "...variable power demands within Douglas and Okanogan counties and under the long-term power sales contracts with ... PacifiCorp".
- 3. PacifiCorp has an interest in this proceeding which cannot be adequately represented by any other party. Therefore, PacifiCorp's intervention is in the public interest.
