Ms. Bose,

The Colville Confederated Tribes ("CCT") wish to clarify a point raised in their comment letter submitted on May 31, 2011, regarding the proper forum for addressing their need for "in kind, in place" mitigation. In that letter, we noted that hatchery issues are typically addressed by the existing Wells HCP Hatchery Committee. CCT remains optimistic that the issues raised in our letter can be successfully addressed within that forum. Accordingly, CCT intends to continue working with Douglas PUD and other HCP Hatchery Committee members to address our concerns and insure that fishery impacts are adequately mitigated.
